



TERRE BRUNE

AOP Maury Sec

Varieties : Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre Vintage 2023

Soil

Black and brown shales on clayey red marls, northern hillside of the northern Pyrenean thrust delimiting the Maury Valley.

Vineyard management

Mechanical work of surface soils, organic amendments, no synthetic inputs and limitation of chemical inputs (sulphur, copper, essential oil of orange peel), biodynamics (respect for lunar cycles, 500/500MT/501, infusions).

Cellar work

Selection and sorting on the plot, manual picking, vinification with native yeasts, long maceration with light interventions.

Aging

Aging in demi-muids (500 l.) of 2 or 3 wines for 8 to 12 months.

Tasting notes

Brick red color, intense and complex nose, expressive palate on ample, powerful and elegant Grenache. The Mourvèdre reinforces the tannic structure and the freshness, while the Syrah completes the aromatic palette on the length.

Food pairing

On assertive meats (legs, duck breasts), cooked or roasted vegetables.
